REQUIREMENTS FOR MAJOR:

44 credits in major

- x no more than 8 credits of which may be at the 100-level
- x at least 4 credits must be numbered HIST 300-level or above
- x At least twenty-four (24) of the total credits needed for the history major must be taken at the University of St. Thomas or in a St. Thomas-approved study abroad program. 200- and 300-level transfer courses require the approval of the department chair to be counted toward the major.
- x The capstone seminar must be taken at St. Thomas.
